Extra trains the day of the Bank of America Chicago Marathon: October 9:

In addition to our regular weekend service, the South Shore Line will operate an extra early morning train arriving in Chicago at 6:04a CST (see schedule to left), allowing Bank of America Chicago Marathon runners and spectators to sit back, relax and ride the South Shore Line.
